Re: Disclosure Request - R. v. McHale

Dear Mr. Bentham:

This is a request for additional disclosure.

1) I request all emails, text messages, notes, meeting records, interview notes etc. regarding any communication between OPP Officers and Clyde Powless from Dec. 1 to Dec. 7, 2007.

2) All video/audio statements made by Clyde Powless between Dec. 1 to Dec. 7, 2007.

3) The same two requests above regarding Camille Powless.

* OPP officers include Greg Moses, Blake Cohoe, Commissioner Fantino, Supt. Cain, Insp. Stephens, Insp. Renton, Sgt. John Murray, Officer Ron Gentle and Chris Lewis.

The above request is based on testimony by Camille Powless, Clyde Powless' sister, who on Nov. 17, 2009 in a Welland courtroom testified that the OPP made a deal with Clyde Powless to get her to file a charge against me.

Camille Powless is currently facing an assault charge (for assaulting me) and a public mischief charge for filing a false police report against me. She testified that Officer Cohoe entered into a deal with Clyde Powless to pressure her to get into the OPP station right way because the OPP wanted to "get Gary McHale on something before the end of the day."

It should be noted that Insp. Renton testified during my preliminary hearing that the OPP entered into negotiations with Clyde Powless prior to my arrest. He testified that Supt. Cain assigned an officer from the ART team to negotiate with Clyde Powless. Blake Cohoe is a member of the ART team.

After Camille Powless went into the OPP station on Dec. 1, 2007 two OPP officers were ordered to find me and arrest me for assaulting Camille Powless. Both officers already testified to this during my preliminary hearing and the fact that it occurred just minutes after Camille gave her statement and without any investigation being done.
