THREE CHARGED DURING ALTERCATION

(HALDIMAND COUNTY, ON.) – Ontario Provincial Police (OPP), Haldimand County detachment have charged three persons with Assault during an altercation at a Surrey St., Caledonia, Haldimand County, ON address.

On Saturday February 18th, 2012 Police attended a Surrey Street address in an effort to maintain public safety, as a number of people had gathered. Several persons became involved in an altercation; police intervened and prevented an assault from taking place. OPP members were also assaulted while conducting an arrest.

As a result of the Police investigation three persons were identified and are now facing charges

- Charged with Assault with a Weapon, Possession of a Weapon for a Dangerous Purpose and Breach of Recognizance is 46 year old Teresa JAMIESON of Six Nations of the Grand River Territory.
- Charged with Assault Police and Assault with Intent to Resist Arrest is 39 year old Justin HILL of Six Nations of the Grand River Territory.
- Charged with Assault Police and Obstruct Police is 52 year old Francine Doxtador of Six Nations of the Grand River Territory.

All are to appear in Provincial Court, Cayuga at a later date to answer to the charges.
